If you are currently (or have in the past) a bisphosphonate drugs (such as Fosamax, Actonel, or Boniva) for osteoporosis or osteopenia, please be aware that is a potential for developing osteonecrosis. Osteonecrosis results in failure to heal and can lead to other lethal complications, including bone and tissue destruction and possible disfigurement. In the event that you do develop osteonecrosis, you may need to be referred to a specialist or to a hospital for additional treatment./ Any and all additional treatment will be at additional cost to you and/or the patient. **IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT YOU INFORM THE DOCTOR IF YOU ARE CURRENTLY OR HAVE IN THE PAST TAKEN ONE OF THESE DRUGS. IT IS ALSO IMPORTANT THAT YOU KEEP YOUR POSTOPERATIVE APPOINTMENTS AND INFORM THE DOCTOR IF YOU FAIL TO HEAL PROPERLY.**
